Ryan White/State Services are available for Texas residents diagnosed with HIV/AIDS. Our program provides medical case management such as assessing current needs, coordination of services and local resources. You may also be eligible for the services listed below:

- HIV related medications through the AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)
- AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance
- Outpatient Ambulatory Care
- Emergency Financial Assistance
- Oral Health services
- Mental Health services
- Housing Assistance (HOPWA)
- Medical Case Management, including medication adherence training/education
- Assistance with payment of health insurance premiums, co-pays and deductibles
- Substance Abuse Treatment services
- Medical Transportation Assistance
- Food Pantry Assistance (Ensure, Boost)
- Other support services

In order to qualify for any of these services, you must meet with the Case Manager to get enrolled. For continued eligibility, you must re-certify every 6 months.
